The description of the railway service facilities of Limited Liability Stevedoring Company Klaipėdos Smeltė (hereinafter - the Company) (hereinafter - the description of the railway services, GPI) intermodal loading and servicing of the Company's multimodal transport unit sets and wagon groups defines the rules, conditions, procedure, information about the price of the service and other necessary information.</p> <p>1.124. The Company is an intermodal loading terminal for multimodal transport units (hereinafter - ITV). Pursuant to GTK Article 30¹, Clause 7, the Company is classified as a seaport facility that provides services related to rail transport.</p>

4.1	Payment information	4.1.1. The amounts and terms of payment for the Service are stipulated in the Contract with the Company. 4.1.2. The prices are determined considering the cost price of the GPI service, the calculated reasonable profit, the market rates of similar services and other criteria.
4.2	Information about discounts	4.2.1. Information on the principles of application of discounts offered to applicants is provided in compliance with the requirements of commercial confidentiality.
5. Conditions of access		
5.1	Legal requirements	5.1.1 The possibility to receive the Service is provided after signing the Contract with the Company. 5.1.2. The Contract is concluded for a year or longer. 5.1.4. The Company provides the Service under the non-discriminatory conditions stipulated in the Contract.
5.2	Technical conditions	5.2.1. The width of the railway track is 1520 mm. 5.2.2. The total length of the structure that fits into the access roads located at the loading terminal of the Company is 645 m. (Road 205 - 389 m, Road 206 - 270 m) 5.2.3. The order of traffic organization is described in the instructions for the organization of traffic on the approach railway roads prepared by the infrastructure manager.
5.3	Provision of rail related services to self	5.3.1. Only the Company provides the Service in the GPI located in the Company's territory.
5.4	IT systems	5.4.1. Access to the Company's IT system is not required.
6. Allocation of capacities		
6.1	Requests for access or use of services	6.1.2. Upon request to receive Access, applicants must fill out and submit a free-form application to the Company by email: smelte@smelte.lt
6.2	Response to request	6.2.1. Upon receipt of the application, confirmation is sent immediately by e-mail. If the application does not provide all the information required and necessary for deciding according to the description of the GPI, the Company informs about this and sets a reasonable deadline for submitting the missing information. If such information is not provided by that deadline, the Application is rejected.

		<p>6.2.2. The Company, having received a duly completed application:</p> <p>6.2.2.1. evaluates the technical and organizational possibilities of providing the Service;</p> <p>6.2.2.2. coordinates the possibility of providing the Service, if the Company's operational capacities are not sufficient to meet the needs specified in the application;</p> <p>6.2.2.3. not later than within 20 workings from the end of the established annual application deadline informs by e-mail about the decision regarding the time, scope and other relevant parameters of the Service provision.</p> <p>6.2.3. After a positive decision on the provision of the Service is made, the Contract is being prepared.</p>
6.3	Information on available capacity and temporary capacity restrictions	<p>6.3.1. Information about changes in the technical characteristics of the railway service facility and temporary capacity limitations, which may have a significant impact on the operation of the GPI, including planned operations, is provided to customers by the e-mail specified in the Contract.</p>
